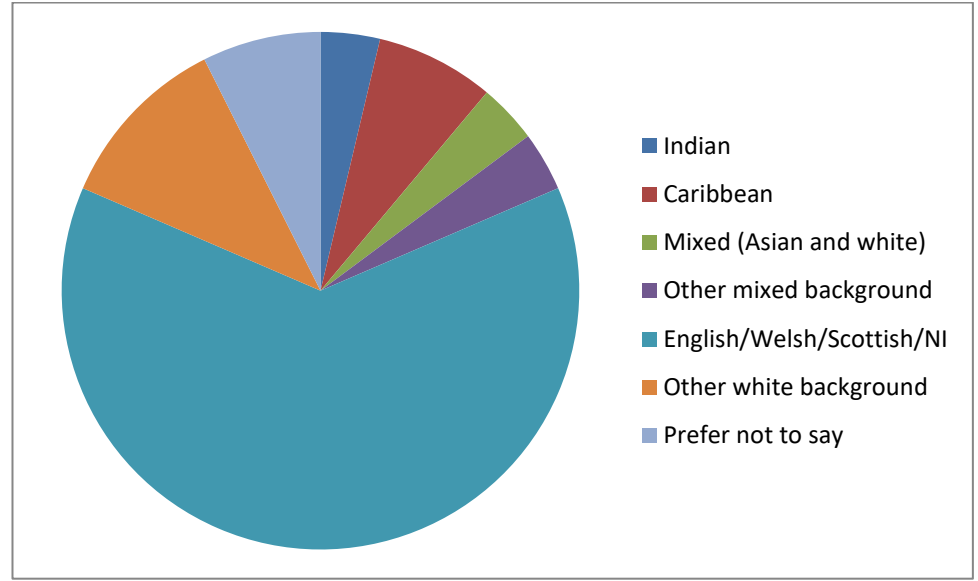


# Diversity Data Survey

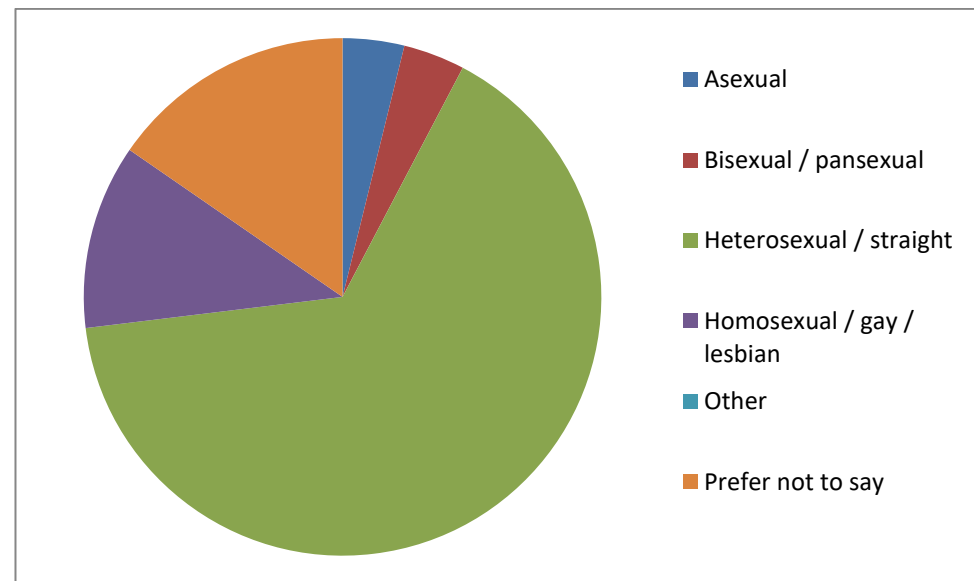

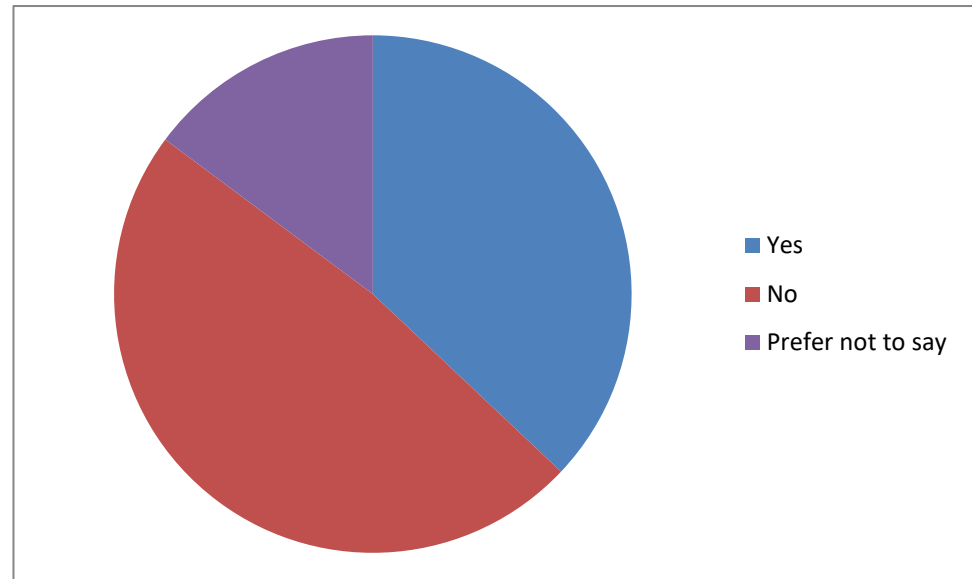
